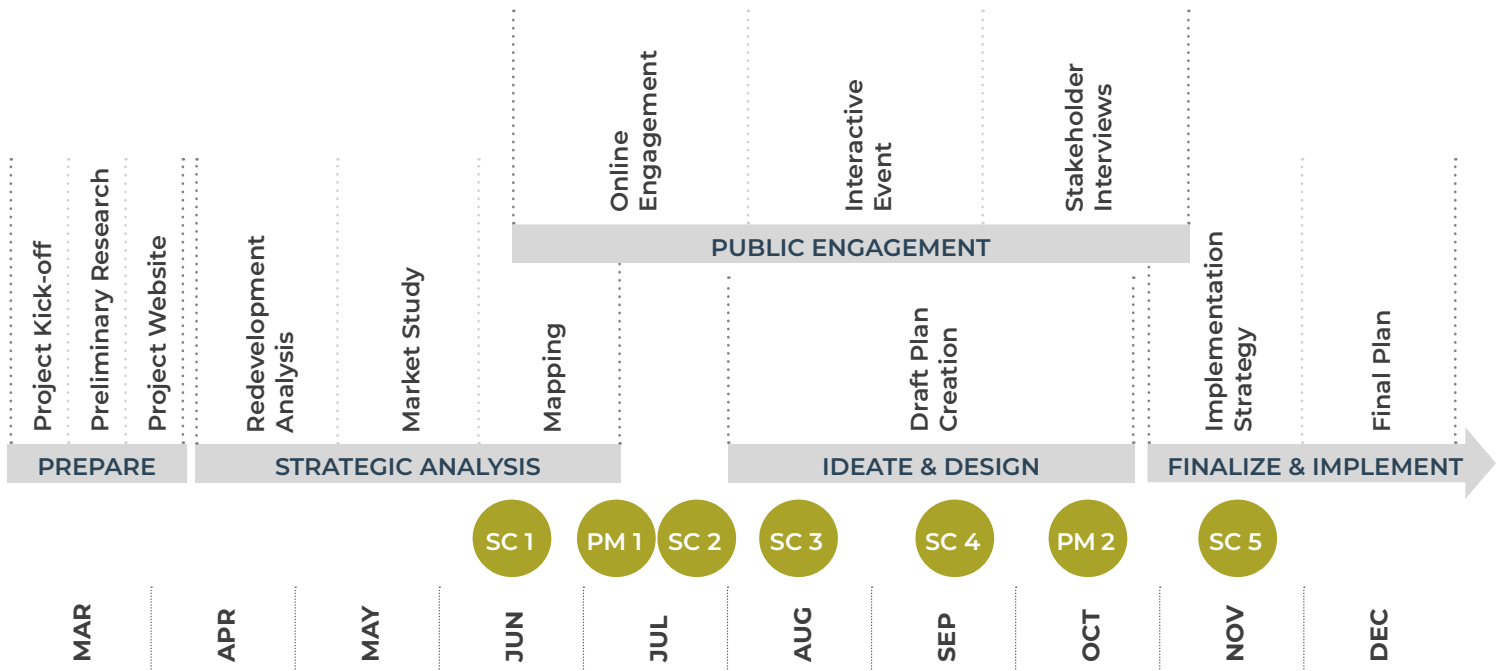
### PLAN OVERVIEW
